Frustration

This is a dream I had on April 16th, 2012. I was very unsettled in my spirit the day before. I spent much time sharing (confessing) my concerns to Gary, a brother of the faith with great emotion. I then had a dream as I was awakening the next morning.

Man-made Security Fails
