The Box

In the early morning of the 10th of May I dreamed of a box. I looked at the sides of this box and wondered how I was supposed to fit into this box. Not only was the length of the box too short, the sides where too low to cover me. I continued to wonder how I would fit into this box and even fiddled with the low sides of the box to see if I could make them higher. Why did I need to fit into this box was not a strong question in this dream-vision and it should have been the only relevant question?

It wasn't until I woke up that I realized this box was a coffin that is associated with pew sitting. In all cases, I was told in different ways – some by implication by 3 separate pastors in the last month to sit in the pews for a while (3-6 months was common) before I could have the right to speak among them. I realized this protective approach represented the three churches I had recently attended seeking fellowship. The box was really a spiritual coffin of pew sitting in requiring I conform to the expectations of the members (really just the pastors) of these three churches to be accepted.

Fear of the Pastors

This fear of these pastors was presented it to me as a righteous concern for the congregation. Was I to be trusted? How well do they know me? Did I have the right doctrine that made them comfortable. Would I dress like them to become accepted? Would I agree to not say anything to the members that might be considered confrontational or controversial? This core fear demanded of me a test of conformity to be assured I was like them with the expectation I would not make them uncomfortable by confronting if I saw errors in doctrinal faith and practice.

I can only admit this is not a Holy Spirit led community of believers with the Body functioning in the gifts and ministries of I Corinthians 12 and Ephesian 5. The church in America has become a corporation of business with leaders who are protecting their asset hold and indirectly a hold upon the minds of the people.

Crises is coming. Some bigger (financially over extended) churches are already feeling the birth pains of this coming economic collapse in America. This is the prophetic word of the Lord.

The Holy Spirit is now going from church to church to test their hearts to find the ones who are completely sold out to the coming mission of YHWH in the final Great Revival. If they are not wholly willing, the Holy Spirit in Revival will not fall upon them.

I suspect there is little room for prophets in any of these three churches or the churches around the world in general. They have already gone the way of the Laodacian church who hire only preachers that will tell them things they want to hear and then assures them of their goodness with a promise for wealth and prosperity.

Cross in the Wilderness

I was then somewhere else alone in nature in this dream-vision



holding my Celtic Cross I often wear. Yes.... I was back in the wilderness like I have been for the last 7 years in training by YHWH as a prophet. I was holding the cross in my left hand and looking at the cross which has the circle over the cross. The symbol of the cross does go back to the first century but not as a single symbol.

It was a part of the Messianic symbol discovered in the Catacombs/Tomb of David in Jerusalem that contained the cross as the eye of the fish, the star of David and the Menorah as a composite symbol.

The fish was more commonly used as a test for finding others of the faith. A half circle would be drawn in the sand and if the person they met was also a believer in Y'Shua as Messiah, he or she would draw another half circle over the other making a fish symbol. The Menorah is symbolic of the 7 Spirits of Power in YHWH, the 7 churches and the 7 natures of YHWH.

The cross is what I normally wear and reminds me of the Hebrew Celtic church that is the only remaining church in the world that has held true to the polity of the Church of Jerusalem as taught to us in the Holy Scriptures and the Didache. It is a symbol for the continuing School of the Prophets ruled by the Melchizedek who is Y'Shua as its High Priest.

Prophetic Church

This Jerusalem model for the prophetic led church is commanded in the Teaching of the Apostles written circa 50 AD (aka Didache). This document and teaching was destroyed within all Hellenist churches by the churches of Constantine and replaced with a Roman hierarchical structure and then added subservient priests/pastors to bishops. The Protestant reform dumped the bishops but did not change this Roman structure with Pastors now at the top. True biblical polity neither exists today in the Roman churches, the Orthodox churches or the Protestant churches who continue as the rebellious children of Rome as they continue to follow the Roman pagan traditions.

As I awakened, I discovered my physical arm was stretched out and I was holding my Celtic cross in my left hand while it was still hanging on a hook near my bed in my wagon where I live. I do not remember reaching for this cross ever during the night but this night it was in my hand when I awoke.

It tells me I must hold onto the model of the Hebrew Church of Y'Shua as led by prophets where it is stated by the earliest writings of the Apostles of Jerusalem,

"In your communities, give your tithe to the prophets since they are now your chief priests."

I should mention that I am not seeking to become the prophet for any of these churches and do not want any of their money. The Apostles taught that a prophet may visit a church that is not his home for 2-3 days, accept only what is needed for him to be there (food and lodging) and then he is to leave and take nothing with him from the church. I am a transient or mobile prophet and thus I am gladly not eligible for income from them.

The real church leadership role is set apart for a group of prophets backed by teachers who are resident in the area in daily serving the people of the Lord. In Jerusalem, everyone was to become Pastors and disciple others. Everyone in Jerusalem were to become Evangelists and bring others to Y'Shua. This early model is the first model despite what many derive from the much later Pauline model which seems more hierarchical and thus Hellenist (Roman). Apostles according to the Jerusalem Apostles is drawn from the prophet and teachers as they are sent out to found churches for short visits.

I can say the modern roll of pastors is NOT the biblical model for heading up church congregations. Those who persist in this Hellenist model will not be blessed as we progress to the rise of the NWO religion. The first church in Jerusalem has from the beginning followed the model of the School of the Prophets founded by Samuel that was transplanted to Ireland in 500 BC by Jeremiah and then planted again in Glastonbury circa 38 AD by James (also called Joseph), the brother of Y'Shua. We are not to follow the so-called pastors who for the most part keep the prophets from speaking to their congregations. Most pastors today I find are seeking financial stability and comfort for themselves and preach to the church what they want to hear and what makes them feel good about themselves so they give. They have become charlatans and not true ministers of Y'Shua.

All three of the churches including one who calls itself the 'Jesus People' church have built or acquired very comfortable auditoriums with an adjacent cafe' for the comfort of their members for a once a week Sunday attendance. If they were really listening to the prophets in these last days, I suggest they would have built community farms and started producing food for their members. This is the true word of YHWH spoken by the prophets to the churches today.

The Antichrist regime readies itself for full world economic collapse and the takeover of America including its churches and the lands of their 501c3 properties. This may not be avoided but the people can be saved if the people and the pastors would have a heart of obedience to listen to the prophets of YHWH in these last days.
