Prophets and Prayer: Dream

At a Large Conference

In an early morning dream of the 3rd of February 2016, I found myself in a large gathering of people such as a conference commonly held by TV evangelists and acclaimed prophets. I was in a large conference room of perhaps 1000 people and found the words being spoken by the speaker were of no consequence to the Kingdom of God. They were just flamboyant words of greatness using the bible that brought glory to the man and not to YHWH. I then remembered that another speaker was next door in an adjacent conference room who called himself a bishop and a prophet and I decided to go and hear this man.

Smaller Gathering

I walked into the adjacent room, I realized it was a small cafe that he was using with perhaps 25 people attending all sitting at tables and at booths. I looked at the speaker and he was dressed in very casual clothes like blue jeans and a golf shirt and had a pony tail of a gray color. He was perhaps 50 years old and slender in build. He in no way matched the image of a bishop or a charismatic speaker. He would be better described as an old hippie. It seems he may have been an older version of Lonnie Frisbee that mentored me briefly in the late 1960's and 70's when I was in my early teens.

Rejected

I then sought to find a seat. I saw a person with family in one of the booths who I knew 45 years ago in the Pilgrim ministry when I was age 15. In the dream I called him Michael but in real life, his name is Larry Fields and he was a cabinet maker. There was an empty seat in his booth and I motioned to him I would sit down and sat. He then said to me, "It is good to see you but I did not say you can sit with us." With this comment, I said nothing and got up and moved farther back in the room and sat alone.

The speaker then continued to speak. Also being a bishop and prophet, I expected this man to say something to me among this small group who had gathered in this small cafe'. This never happened. The only thing I remember this bishop-prophet saying is, "We need to pray diligently and continuously to bring in the souls who would be saved from the deceptions of the Antichrist." The dream then ended.

Reflections

Two things are evident in this dream. First, the true prophets are yet to acknowledge each other in terms that draws them together in strength. It says in I Corinthians 14, "Let the prophets speak and let the other prophets judge the prophecies." This is necessary to assure the words that are coming from God are trustworthy. The last day prophets are still being trained individually and most of them alone in various versions of the wilderness. The day will come when they will gather together in villages to strengthen each other in the faith.

Prophets and teachers are greatly needed today as per the instructions and leadership model of the Didache which is perhaps the only remaining account of the polity employed in the first church in Jerusalem who functioned as a Hebrew church and not as a Hellenist church in service to the Roman Empire. When a prophecy is presented, the teachers assure it does not conflict with the Canon of scripture and then the prophets assure it comes from the Spirit of God and not from a deceptive spirit of the Antichrist.

This dream included persons of the early revival of the Jesus People in California, Oregon and Hawaii in the late 1960's to the 1980's. This group were largely hippies or sometimes called Jesus Freaks and this dream seems to be connected with an earlier dream I was given on the 20th of November 2015 that I titled, "Pilgrims Resurrected." In this earlier dream, I was shown the Pilgrims as a ministry who served in Hawaii are to be resurrected in these end times and restructured as a Guild of Artists and not a conventional church structure.

The message of the bishop-prophet is timely and the core focus of the regathering of the Pilgrims in these end times is now. The message is, "We need to pray diligently and continuously to bring in the souls who would be saved from the deceptions of the Antichrist." In this, this mandate and mission for the new Pilgrims is to gather together to begin to pray for the salvation of souls.
